

Meeting Minutes – May 11, 2021

MUSIC DIRECTOR REPORTS:

- **BHS – Mr. Allen:**
 - Thanked Music Boosters, parents, students for a successful year despite all obstacles
 - Upcoming events: BHS band concert 5/19 w/awards (Senior parents only); 5/25 – drumline auditions; 5/26 - field commander and squad leader tryouts
 - NO MEMORIAL DAY PARADE; (2) trumpet players will do Taps at the cemetery

- **BHS – Mrs. Gess:**
 - First in-person concert of the year will be Monday, May 17
 - Groups will participate in both Baccalaureate and the graduation ceremony

- **BHS/BMS – Mrs. Singler:**
 - Honors Quintet, Taps players and singers will participate in Memorial Day ceremony
 - May 26 – Honors Quintet / Rocket Quartet auditions during class
 - Leadership training will be after school on May 26
 - Fall spirit wear is requested for orchestra
 - Day for Strings will be back in 2021, on Thursday, November 4
 - Chamber Winds will also restart in the fall

- **BHS – Mr. Awad:**
 - Congratulated all those involved with the musical Chicago, which was a huge success
 - First “all band” rehearsal for BMS band will be May 13
 - End of year concert will be on Sunday 5/23 at BHS stadium (weather permitting) or at two separate times in the gym

- **BHS – Mrs. Rohlke:**
