

**BAY MUSIC BOOSTERS
ROWLAND F. HOSMER
SUMMER MUSIC CAMP SCHOLARSHIP**

Each year the Bay Music Boosters offer a unique opportunity for several Bay Schools instrumental and choir music students to attend a music camp with a scholarship through the Rowland Hosmer Music Camp Scholarships. These awards are available to students in grades 3 through 11 who are in the instrumental and choral music program. The awards are given based solely on the merit of the student and the camp program, not on academics or need. Up to 15 music students whose families are Booster members will receive a \$150 Scholarship. Students will be selected by the Bay School Music Directors and Boosters.

The scholarships are intended to help defray the cost of the selected camps, not necessarily to pay for them in the entirety. The scholarships are not intended for travel with a local ensemble. We hope you will encourage your student to consider a summer music camp experience. Private teachers receive information about camps. Local music stores often have lists for summer camps. You may also look in the music hall at the Middle School and High School for the latest listings. In addition, you can find camps online. *There are camps for everyone!*

To apply for a Rowland F. Hosmer Summer Camp Scholarship, the student must:

1. Submit an application to the camp of their choice and pay any applicable deposits, keeping a copy of the application.
2. Complete the application for the Rowland F. Hosmer Summer Camp Scholarship.
3. Email the application, with the copy of the summer camp application, to pres@bayvillagebandboosters.org

Applications must be received by May 27, 2022.

The recipients of the Rowland F. Hosmer Summer Camp Scholarships will be announced at the spring concerts. The scholarship money will be sent directly to the camp attended. This is a great opportunity for your child to enhance his/her playing ability and to enjoy camp!

You will need to apply to the camp of your choice by the date required by the specific camp and remit any deposits required. The scholarship monies awarded will pay for at least a portion of the camp tuition and will be sent directly to the camp. If the amount awarded and the portion remitted by the parent is more than the camp tuition, a refund will be sent by the camp to the parent. Good Luck!
