Treasury Report thru 8/31/22

IRS Penalty of \$ 720 has been waived. Penalty was based on an incorrect filing prior to my position.

We started FY 22-23 with approx \$ 38K in the operating account. This does not account for the investment/savings accounts set aside for uniforms. Of this \$ 38K, around \$ 12K is being put towards last year director instrument purchases still pending. So cash to spend, \$ 26K.

Fundraising started out this year with Membership bringing in (so far) \$ 43K. Expenses were only \$ 2,000 for the drive. Donations are still adding up as September rolls on. Really amazing!

Membership Drive: History of the event draws many donations of course and the signs around the city remind alumni and they donate.

Other fun facts:

Boosters help around 900 students. 142 participated in the drive.

Only around 500 kids are high school age and are allowed to participate.

The Drive has 56 routes. 41 were covered.

*587 residents gave at the door. That is out of 5800 households. That is roughly 10%
18 of our teams earned over \$ 1000 per route.*

Food for thought:

How do we increase participation?

How do we include more middle school families?

How do we involve more high school kids that benefit from the Boosters!

Rockettes had a car wash that raised \$ 1,600!

In addition to that the Rockettes had their annual Rockette Camp, with Liz and Spenser modifying the format slightly to accommodate more kids. They raised over \$ 5,200 with expenses only adding up to \$ 1,400.

The use of technology, credit cards, QR codes, etc. added up to just about \$ 1000 - but I feel the convenience of the ease of payment at uniform night, tuxedo night & membership drive really was worth it.

Now that we have an established credit card we have earned \$ 90.78 cash back on our purchases - that is fun!

Cash in the bank as of now sits around \$ 75K. We have some of the Directors wish lists in hand and am waiting on others.

Uniform fund sits around \$ 113K.

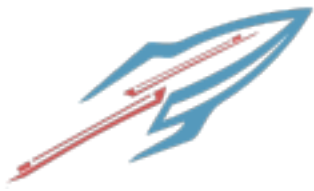

DEFINITION OF EXCUSED ABSENCE AND PROCEDURES FOR REPORTING AN ABSENCE

Excused Absences:

All orchestra members are required to attend all orchestra events assigned to their ensemble. The only excuses for missing required events are as follows*:

1. **A court or legal case that cannot be changed.**
2. **Personal illness severe enough that the student cannot attend school.**
3. **Participation in another school event as determined by Administration.**
4. **A death in the family.**

*Other extenuating circumstances may be excused at the discretion of the director.

Reporting Knowable Performance Conflicts:

If you have a scheduling conflict with a date on the orchestra calendar, the director must be notified in writing ASAP and no later than 30 days prior to any performance or evening rehearsal.

Reporting Illness the day of a Performance:

If your child becomes ill the day of a performance, please let me know ASAP with a text or voicemail: **440-941-2135**.

Absence Make-up Assignments: Choose ONE of the following two make-up assignments. Excused absences can be made up for full credit. Unexcused absences can be made up for half credit.

1. **Composer Research**
 - a. **5th & 6th Grade** List 25 facts about a composer who wrote music for your instrument. Be sure to include a Bibliography with your sources listed correctly. The assignment is due no later than two weeks after the concert you missed.
 - b. **8th Grade** Compose a 500-word essay about a composer who wrote music for your instrument. Be sure to include a Bibliography with your references listed correctly. The essay is due no later than two weeks after the concert you missed.
 - c. **High School** Compose a 1,000-word essay (2,000 words for State Contest) about a composer whose music we have performed in class. Be sure to include a Bibliography with your references listed correctly. The essay is due no later than two weeks after the concert you missed. Rubric on google classroom.
2. **Recording & Self-Assessment** Submit a recording of your entire part for each piece to be performed at the missed performance & include the personal assessment (see www.bayorchestra.com, google classroom, or Mrs. Singler for the make-up assignment form.) High School: State Contest absence also requires a live sight-reading performance.
