## BAY MUSIC BOOSTERS ROWLAND F. HOSMER SUMMER MUSIC CAMP SCHOLARSHIP

Each year, the Bay Music Boosters offer a unique opportunity for 3rd through 11th grade instrumental and choir music students to attend a music camp with a scholarship through the Rowland Hosmer Music Camp Scholarships. These awards are given based solely on a student's musical merit and camp program rather than academics or financial need. Up to 15 music students whose families are Booster members will receive a \$150 scholarship. The Bay School Music Directors and Boosters will select scholarship recipients.

The scholarships should help defray the cost of the chosen music camps, not necessarily pay for them in their entirety. They are not intended for travel with a local ensemble. We hope you will encourage your student to consider a summer music camp experience.
